## GCA 2018 Student Film Festival – Contest Rules

1. Submissions can only be made by students currently enrolled in a public or private Georgia college/ university associated with the Georgia Communication Association (GCA). Recent (2017) graduates of a GCA member school may submit, but must adhere to the remainder of the guidelines.
2. Five genres of films will be accepted to the competition, but there are not separate categories for awards. Submission categories are as follows: documentary, experimental, narrative, animation and music video.
3. Films must be no longer than ten minutes.
4. Films must have been created within the past calendar year (2017).
5. Only one entry per student; however, there is no limit to the number of films that may be submitted from any one GCA member institution.
6. A faculty member is required to be listed on all student entries. You must identify the faculty sponsor's name, title and contact information.
7. Student's film must be submitted with the student's name, institution, contact information, film title, run time, sponsoring faculty, and the faculty member's contact information.
8. Creativity is encouraged. In an effort to maintain the spirit of the conference and festival, judges may consider excessive/gratuitous use of offensive language, use of unsubstantiated assertions, and pornography of any kind grounds for disqualification from consideration.
9. This is a competitive festival; submission does not mean your work will be screened at the GCA Student Film Festival. Judges will view the submissions and use a common rubric to tally final scores that decide the best works submitted. You will be notified at least one week in advance if your work will be screened at the festival on February 16, 2018, in Macon at Columbus State Univ.
10. Violation of any of the aforementioned stipulations will result in disqualification from the festival.

Festival winners will be recognized on Friday evening, Feb. 16, at the GCA 2018 Annual Conference during the "Dinner and a Movie" event.
